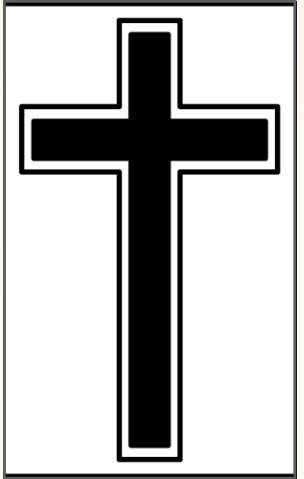

BACKGROUND OF CURSILLO

Cursillo (pronounced Kur-See-Yo) is a Spanish word meaning "short course". A Cursillo weekend is a short, intensive course in Christian living. The Cursillo has been an active tool of Church renewal since its beginning in Majorca, Spain in the late 1940's, and was brought to the United States in 1957.

Atlanta Christian Cursillo was formed in 1977 and is an ecumenical movement for all Christians interested in strengthening their walk with Christ.

WHAT HAPPENS ON A CURSILLO WEEKEND?

The Cursillo teaches the fundamental concepts of living a Christian life. The Cursillo weekend begins on a Thursday evening and ends the following Sunday evening. During the weekend, participants

will hear a series of talks each day given by laymen and pastors. The talks deal with living one's life in God's grace. The emphasis is on total commitment and the ways God strengthens and guides His people. **The atmosphere of the Cursillo weekend is one of Love, Joy, Worship, and Fellowship!**

WHO SHOULD ATTEND CURSILLO?

Cursillo is designed for those who desire to be strengthened in their faith and to be brought closer to Christ in their discipleship. Men and women attend separate weekends. Husbands must attend prior to their wives, and singles are also invited to attend.



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER CURSILLO?

Following the three-day weekend, Cursillo provides an opportunity for participants to be part of an ongoing support community. The intention is to expand one's inner spiritual life and to help believers become more active disciples of Christ in the world and in their churches.
