The Purpose of Atlanta Christian Cursillo

The Cursillo weekend is a structured well thought-out method of providing the participants an opportunity to reflect on their own faith. This is accomplished through a setting which allows them to have a personal encounter with Christ.

The movement's primary concern is to make stronger leaders within their own particular church. Therefore, one of the main goals is to strengthen the effectiveness of the local church.

Background of Cursillo

Cursillo (pronounced Kur-See-Yo) is a Spanish word meaning a short course. A Cursillo weekend is a short intensive course in Christian living. The Cursillo has been an active tool of the church renewal since its beginning in Majorca Spain in the late 1940's and was brought to the United States in 1957.

Atlanta Christian Cursillo was formed in 1977 and is an ecumenical movement open to all Christians interested in strengthening their walk with Christ.

What Happens on A Cursillo Week-end?

The Cursillo teaches what is fundamental to living a Christian life. The Cursillo weekend begins on a Thursday evening and ends the following Sunday evening. During the weekend you will hear a series of talks each day given by laymen and pastors. The talks deal with living ones life in God's grace. The emphasis is on total commitment and the ways God strengthens and guides his people.

The atmosphere of the Cursillo weekend is one of love, joy, worship and fellowship.

Who Should Attend A Cursillo?

Cursillo is designed for those who desire to be strengthened in their faith and to be brought closer to Christ in their discipleship. There are separate weekends for men and women. Husbands must attend prior to their wives. Singles are also invited to attend.

What Happens After Cursillo?

Following the three day weekend, Cursillo provides an opportunity for you to be a part of an ongoing support community. The intention is to expand your inner spiritual life and to help you become a more active disciple of Christ both in the world and through your church.

How May I Attend?

If you would like to experience a Cursillo weekend, fill out and mail the attached application. Be sure and have your sponsor and your pastor sign your application.
